

What is the price of electricity in the Congo?

Democratic Republic of the Congo, September 2022: The price of electricity is 0.080 U.S. Dollar per kWhfor households and 0.093 U.S. Dollar for businesses which includes all components of the electricity bill such as the cost of power, distribution and taxes.

Less than 10% of the Congolese population has access to electricity,35% in urban areas (50% in Kinshasa) and less than 1% in rural areas.
