The EPA, CPSC, and FDA have specific regulations for cleaning supplies, including chemical safety, labeling, and product registration requirements. Most cleaners fall under HTS Chapter 34, which covers soap, detergents, and other surface-active agents. A customs bond is required to clear most cleaning products through U.S. Customs.

Customs does not permit the grouping of marks or numbers on a shipment of mixed commodities. Most documents presented for use in customs clearance processing must be prepared in Chinese to avoid delays and expedite clearance processing.
