1. Check if you need planning permission. Most households in the UK don"t need planning permission to get solar panels installed.. Rooftop solar almost always falls under the owner"s permitted development rights, which allow you to make reasonably sized improvements to your home without planning permission.

The solar panels generate DC (direct current - like a battery) electricity, which is then converted in an inverter to AC (alternating current - like the electricity in your domestic socket). Solar PV systems are rated in kilowatt peak (kWp). A 1kWp solar PV system would require 3 solar panels on your roof.

Most solar panels come with a warranty of 20-25 years, but with regular maintenance, they can continue producing energy for up to 30-40 years. Can I install solar panels on a flat roof? Yes, you can install solar panels on a flat roof. By using angled mounting racks, the panels can be positioned to capture maximum sunlight effectively.
